
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



It is strong enough to handle any task, and the open-side frame design allows easy access for threading and tying up. Our basic 4-shaft, 6-treadle model allows for expansion to up to 10 shafts, 10 treadles. The Standard's versatility makes it a great choice for everyone, whether you have years of experience or are just starting out.

For those wanting to weave more intricate patterns, we have 12- to 16-shaft looms available. (There are modifications to these higher-shaft looms, so the basic Standard is not easily converted to more than 10-shafts.) For comfortable weaving, the treadles are narrower so that it is not hard to reach them all. The shafts are thinner, allowing them to sit closer together, aiding in clean sheds.



With a 27" weaving width, the Victoria is the widest of our table-top looms and can be transported with a project on it. The 4-lever system locks the shed in an open position. 

#### A note from Madelyn van der Hoogt

If you've ever been frustrated by the limited number of blocks possible on a shaft loom, the drawloom is for you. A shaft drawloom provides from ten to fifty blocks; a single-unit drawloom allows hundreds. You can weave these multi-block designs in damask, turned twill, lace weaves, tied weaves, and more. I love knowing that the only other loom that can produce such complex patterning is an electronic Jacquard loom, but when I weave on my drawloom I am using technology that is thousands of years old.

#### How to measure looms

Knowing the correct size of your loom is very important when ordering parts. Glimakra looms are most easily identified by their metric measurements and have come in many sizes over the years. 100 cm, 120 cm, 150 cm, and 160 cm are the currently available sizes. Discontinued sizes of the Standard are 110 cm and 135 cm. The Ideal looms have been discontinued but they were produced in 60 cm, 70 cm, 80 cm 90 cm and 100 cm. To measure a Standard or Ideal loom, measure the length of the breast beam between the inside frame uprights. If you need parts for a loom, knowing the width of the loom and the length of the part can make it much easier for us to get you the right parts.

The Sectional warp beam consists of four wooden boards with holes drilled for metal loops dividing the beam into 25 mm (1") sections. The boards are attached with screws directly to the original warp beam and the metal loops are inserted in the holes. Sectional warping is an alternative to making a warp chain and then winding it on. In sectional warping, you warp and wind on at the same time so that one step is saved. Presleying or the use of a raddle is also eliminated. Sectional warping is done so that you wind on the full length of all warp threads that will go within each section. That means that you will need to have as many spools as you need warp ends in each section.






Winders come with either a fine spindle or thicker spindle, which is made for the larger plastic bobbins. The fine spindle is more versatile as you can also wind the larger bobbins on them. Put a 3- inch section of cardboard quill on the spindle and slide the larger bobbin on top of the quill; it is usually a perfect fit. If you weave with fine threads, the thinner shuttles, quills, and fine-spindle bobbin winder may be preferable. Swifts are warrantied 1 year and have been manufactured for more than 80 years in Sweden. Repair slats are available for the swifts.

#### The fastest hemstiching







Leave a weft-thread tail 3 times the width of the warp before you start weaving and weave about 1 inch. Thread the weft tail into a needle. Take the needle under the first 5 warp threads (below the first row of weaving), then around those 5 threads and bring it up inside the loop made by the stitch (Photo a).\*Take the needle down into the cloth above the first 2 weft threads, under next 5 warp threads to the left, and then bring it back up below the first weft (Photo b). Take the needle around these 5 warp threads and bring it up through the loop made by the stitch (Photo c). Repeat from\*

The use of the arrow peg or anchor peg is a further refinement, making tie up and use of the cord even easier.

We stock almost every size heddle in use and can supply the appropriate heddle length for your loom. We also stock the Texsolv cord on spools of 20 meters (22 yds), 50 meters (55 yds), and in boxes of 250 meters. We also have the heavy beam cord, anchor pins, and arrow pegs.
